Education System Overview

Major school holidays/break:

- Winter vacation: June – July
- Summer vacation: mid or late November - mid or late January

Structure of the university system:

- **Years of study required to earn a bachelor's degree:** 4 years
- **The language of instruction in universities:** Spanish
Years of required English instruction in universities: Depends on the university and on the university program.
- **Degrees offered:** Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's and some universities grant PhD's.
