• Language of instruction: Kyrgyz and Russian

Structure of the university system:

- Years of study required to earn a bachelor's degree: 4 years
- The language of instruction in universities: Generally Russian and Kyrgyz languages, but there are few private universities that instruct in English or Turkish languages.
- Degrees offered: Specialist, Bachelors, Masters and Doctorate
