- **Language of instruction:** Kyrgyz and Russian

Structure of the university system:

- **Years of study required to earn a bachelor's degree:** 4 years
- **The language of instruction in universities:** Generally Russian and Kyrgyz languages, but there are few private universities that instruct in English or Turkish languages.
- **Degrees offered:** Specialist, Bachelors, Masters and Doctorate
