Sustainability Study Abroad Program in Vietnam

Loyola University Chicago was awarded a U.S. Department of State Capacity Building for Study Abroad Grant in 2012. Through the grant, Loyola aimed to develop and enhance study abroad capacity in Vietnam for U.S. undergraduates. The programs involved partnering with Vietnamese institutions and focused on sustainability. Over 30 students, including many non-traditional students, participated in the initial program and nine Vietnamese faculty engaged in study abroad capacity-building efforts.


The grant funding was utilized to focus on programs in Vietnam, which helped to diversify locations where U.S. students study abroad.
